# **Updates to Student Particulars**

- Parents are requested to inform teachers and email HSS immediately if there are any changes in your child's particulars (status, stream, or mainstream school)
- The fee structure depends on residential status, and accuracy is important for proper reporting to the Board.
- Please note that we have a deadline for student data submission. If a change occurs in a student's residential status after the deadline, or if we receive the information after the deadline, the fee for that semester will be applicable based on the previous status. Parents are always notified by message before the submission date to update any changes.

# **Student Transfer & Withdrawal Updates**

- **A. Organisation Transfer**: 'Movement of Student Transfer' form is required when transferring a student between organisations. Available on the HSS website.
- **B. For withdrawals from NTIL**, parents must submit the Withdrawal Form along with the School Leaving Certificate / New School Admission letter.
- **C. For internal transfers** (between HSS centres or from mainstream schools), the current form remains valid.

# **Relocation or Admission to International School**

If your child is relocating or enrolling in an international school and will not be continuing with NTIL, please:

- Email the Hindi Society, and
- Submit the Withdrawal Form along with supporting documents (such as the admission letter from the new school or the school leaving certificate from the current mainstream school).

# For Primary 6 and O-Level Parents (Sec 1 & A-Level Admission)

After receiving your child's results/posting, please inform the teacher if your child will continue with HSS. Kindly submit the following documents:

- Transfer Form: (e.g., PSLE to Sec 1 / Sec 4 to A Level)
- PDPA Consent Form
- PSLE/O-Level Certificate & Result Slip
- DSA/School Posting SMS or Email (printed copy)
- Proof of Status:
  - SC: Citizenship Certificate / Singapore Passport
  - SPR: Re-entry Permit
  - IS: FIN card

# Note: If your child is not continuing with HSS after PSLE/O-Level or at any other level, and is transferring to another organisation, please submit the Transfer Form to the HSS office or your teacher.

# **Result Submission & Award Eligibility**

We request parents to share your child's result with the teacher before the deadline, so they can submit it to the HSS office. Submitting your child's results is important for several reasons, including data collection, eligibility checks for the SBB, and consideration for student awards. We invite the students to the Award Ceremony who achieved AL1 in the PSLE, A1 in the O-Level, and A in the A-Level exams. Certificates will be emailed to: PSLE: AL2, AL3 and O-Level: A2 students.

# **Notes for Fees**

We strongly encourage all parents to make fee payments via GIRO. Using GIRO not only streamlines the payment process but also ensures smoother and more efficient transactions. Please note that you will receive an invoice for the fees, and all payments must be made by **15th August**. A late payment fee of **\$20** will apply to any payments received after this date. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in ensuring timely payments.
