Dear Parents and Students,

Namaste!

Please find below the important information regarding the upcoming Weighted Assessments.

For Weighted Assessment 1, the assessment will be centralised for Primary 3 to Primary 6, as well as Secondary 3 and Secondary 4/5. **Secondary 1 and Secondary 2 students will prepare PowerPoint presentations, followed by presentations at their respective weekend centres/schools.**

For Weighted Assessment 2, the assessment will be centralised for all levels. Primary 6 and Secondary 4/5 students will have their assessment in Term 2, while all other levels will have it in Term 3.

Important Points: Centralised Weighted Assessments

1. Entry proof has been distributed to all Primary 6 and Secondary 4 students. For the other levels, entry proof will be distributed closer to the assessment date. Please ensure that students arrive on time at the examination centre.
2. Parents are not allowed to enter the examination centre.
3. Parents who are driving may park in the nearest car park and drop off/pick up their child at the school gate.
4. Students are required to bring their **entry proof, ID, stationery, and a water bottle.**
5. Students must follow all guidelines at the examination centre.
6. **Students must bring a pen for writing the examination paper.**
7. **Students are not allowed to use pencils or erasable pens to write any of the Weighted Assessment Papers. This applies to all the levels from Primary 3 to Secondary 5.**

Guidelines for Valid Reason (VR)

You must email your VR request to hindi@hindi-society.com at least ten (10) working days before the examination date, with all relevant supporting documents attached. Please copy (cc) your child's Hindi teacher in the email.

- Late, unsupported, or same-day requests will not be considered.
- Please do not assume that a VR will be granted. Kindly wait for official confirmation; we will respond as soon as practicable.
- The process for VR mark calculation is confidential. If VR is approved, your child will not be marked absent and will not be penalised in their results.

Absence Due to Medical Reasons

- If your child is unwell on the day of the exam:
- Please submit a Medical Certificate (MC) dated on the day of the exam to the teacher immediately. The MC must clearly state that the student was unfit to attend the exam.
- If your child requires special arrangements for health or other reasons, please inform us well in advance.

Last-minute requests cannot be accommodated.

Please note the following points regarding the return of weighted assessment scripts for Primary 3 to Primary 6 and Secondary 4 students:

1. Please return the script to the respective teacher by the stated deadline.
2. If you notice any discrepancies, please note them and inform the teacher by email.
3. If a student is absent on the script submission day, parents should make arrangements to return the script to the teacher.
4. Students and parents should not circle or correct any errors on the script.
5. Do not write, scribble, or make any other markings on the script. Please keep it safely and return it on time.
